

International Internship Programs

Germany Internship Abroad [WHU-Otto Beisheim School of Management](#)

Students earn 15 credits, study German and participate in an internship in a program at the Otto Beisheim School of Management at WHU near Koblenz, Germany. Students spend four weeks taking an intensive language and information seminar at WHU, which is followed by a full-time 15-week internship. In conjunction with the internship, students complete a significant research project in English and give an oral presentation in German at the end of the program. *

Location: Vallendar, Germany

- Charming and historic university town located in the scenic Rhine River Valley
- Close to Koblenz, Frankfurt and Cologne

Program Dates:

Fall or Spring semester

Program Organization:

- Four-week intensive German-language instruction at WHU
- One-week European Study Tour
- 15-week internship

Academic Program:

- Six credits for the research paper
- Six credits of German language
- 1.5 credits for the EST
- 1.5 credits for MGT 450I, an online internship course

Housing:

While living in Vallendar, students have the following options for housing: modern university dorms, apartment in Vallendar, dorm-style housing in a convent. The students will then move to the city where their internship is located.

Prerequisites:

- Have completed five semesters' worth of course work (75 credits)
- Have a 3.0 cumulative and professional GPA
- Have completed German 301D and MECO 292
- Have completed all Professional Requirements with the exception of OSCM 230 & 356

Estimated Costs:

- Washington University tuition and health fee
- EST - \$800
- Housing - varies based on location of internship - €1,750
- Food - €250 per month (€1,250)
- Personal expenses - €300 per month (€1,500)
- Airfare - \$1,800

*Students may also choose to do a traditional study abroad semester in English with no German Pre-requisites.
