Hong Kong Study Abroad [Chinese University of Hong Kong](#)

Olin has a reciprocal exchange program with CUHK, which was established in October 1963 as Hong Kong's second university. CUHK was the first university in Hong Kong to have student exchange and study abroad programs. CUHK is particularly strong in the areas of Chinese economy, corporate finance and the emerging financial markets of China and Asia. It excels by virtue of its history and geography and contributes to Hong Kong's strength as a hub of international trade and finance through teaching, research, consultancy and public service.

Fall or spring semester

Academic Program:

- 15 credits in English based on course work selected from the undergraduate offerings

Housing:

There are 21 undergraduate dormitories that constitute the four colleges of CUHK. Students share a double- or triple-occupancy room with local students who have expressed special interest in sharing a room with a foreign roommate.

Prerequisites:

- Have completed five semesters' worth of course work (75 credits)
- Have a 3.0 cumulative and professional GPA
- Have completed all Professional Requirements with the exception of OSCM 230 & 356

Estimated Semester Costs:

- Washington University tuition and health fee
- Housing - HK \$5,624-\$12,000
- Food - HK \$12,000
- Transportation, personal and incidental expenses - HK \$8,000
- Student visa application fee - HK \$430-\$470
- Airfare to and from the States - U.S. \$2,000
