

## International Internship Programs

### Israel Internship Abroad [Interdisciplinary Center \(IDC\) Herzliya](#)

IDC is a member of the Washington University McDonnell International Scholars Academy. Students have the opportunity to combine their interests in business and Israeli culture by completing a full-time 10-week internship and taking a minimum of six credits chosen from the academic offerings at IDC. In conjunction with the internship, participants will complete a significant research project in English and perform an oral presentation of their research.

**Location:** Herzliya, Israel

- Center of entrepreneurial activity and economic development in Israel
- Suburb of Tel Aviv

**Program Dates:**

Spring semester

**Academic Program:**

- Six credits of business or culture courses chosen by the student from the IDC offerings
- Six credits for an applied research paper
- 1.5 credits of colloquium and practicum through the Zell Entrepreneurship Program
- 1.5 credits of MGT 450I internship course offered

**Housing:**

IDC will provide university-leased, furnished apartments near campus, with two to a room.

**Prerequisites:**

- Have completed five semesters' worth of course work (75 credits)
- Have a 3.0 cumulative and professional GPA
- Have completed MECO 292 and all Professional Requirements with the exception of OSCM 230 & 356

**Estimated 2011 Costs:**

- Washington University tuition and health fee
- Housing - \$3,000 plus utilities (\$1,000 deposit)
- Food - \$2,000
- Personal expenses - \$1,500
- Airfare - \$2,000
