Olin has a reciprocal exchange program with Università Bocconi, which was the first Italian institution of higher education to grant a degree in economics and is considered the leading university in business and economics in Italy. Bocconi exchanges 1,000 students every year with more than 180 universities worldwide and belongs to two of the most prestigious international networks: CEMS (Community of European Management Schools) and PIM (Partnership in International Management).

Location: Milan, Italy

- Largest metropolitan area in Italy
- Located in Lombardy
- Known as a world fashion and design capital
- A major global influence in commerce, sports, art and media

Program Dates:

Fall or spring semester

Program Organization:

- Intensive Italian-language course that begins before classes start
- Olin students enroll in a maximum of six courses in English per term chosen from undergraduate courses (codes 5xxx and 6xxx)

Academic Program:

- 12-15 credits of business course work in English
- Italian language course (pass/fail)

Housing:

Students will live in university-owned apartments near campus.

Prerequisites:

- Have completed five semesters' worth of course work (75 credits)
- Have a 3.0 cumulative and professional GPA
- Have completed all Professional Requirements with the exception of OSCM 230 & 356

Estimated Costs:

- Washington University tuition and health fee
- Housing - €400-€800 per month (€ 3000)
- Food - €4 per meal at canteen (€ 1,250)
- Personal expenses* - €300 per month (€1,500)
- Airfare - \$2,000
