### Singapore Study Abroad [Singapore Management University](#)

Olin has a reciprocal exchange program with Singapore Management University. Set up as Singapore's first publicly funded autonomous university offering a style of education modeled after The Wharton School, SMU occupies a state-of-the-art city campus located in the heart of Singapore's civic, cultural and business districts.

**Location:** Singapore

- Leading financial center

**Program Dates:** Fall or Spring Semester

**Academic Program:**

- 4 SMU credits in English based on coursework selected from undergraduate offerings (1 credit course = 3 credit hours per semester)
- Optional supply chain practicum with SMU students

**Prerequisites:**

- Have completed 5 semesters worth of course work (75 credits)
- 3.0 cumulative and professional GPA
- All Professional Requirements with the exception of OSCM 230 & 356

**Estimated Costs:**

- Washington University Tuition and health fee
- Rent approximately S\$900-S\$1800 per month
- Food: S\$300 - S\$500
- Local Transportation: S\$100 - S\$150 per month
- Books: S\$30 – S\$100
- Misc. Fees S\$250, including health insurance required by Singaporean government
- Personal expenses : S\$100 – S\$300 per month
- Airfare to and from the States - US \$2,000
