

International Internship Programs

Spain Study Abroad [Universidad Carlos III de Madrid](#)

This is a direct enrollment program with Universidad Carlos III de Madrid, one of the newer institutions of higher education in Spain. Students will typically enroll in at least four courses of study, with at least half of the courses being taken in the business school. Before starting classes at Universidad Carlos III de Madrid, Olin students participate in a four-week intensive language preparation experience in Seville.

Location: Madrid, Spain

- Capital and largest city in Spain
- Rich in culture and history

Program Dates:

Fall or Spring semester

Program Organization:

- Four-week intensive Spanish-language instruction in Seville
- One-week European Study Tour (EST) - Spring
- 12 credits at Universidad Carlos III de Madrid

Academic Program:

- Nine credits for course work in business or cultural studies in English or Spanish
- Three credits of Spanish language
- 1.5 credits for EST

Housing:

Housing is typically off campus with a family in Madrid (homestay) or in single-occupancy rooms in a shared apartment arrangement. Housing accommodations are arranged by our partner in Madrid, ACCENT.

Prerequisites:

- Have completed five semesters' worth of course work (75 credits)
- Have a 3.0 cumulative and professional GPA
- Have completed Spanish 307D and 308D
- Have completed all Professional Requirements with the exception of OSCM 230 & 356

Estimated Costs:

- Washington University tuition and health fee
- European Study Tour - \$800
- Food - €170 per month
- Apartment Housing €3,566.00
- Homestay € 5450.00 includes two meals per day
- Miscellaneous -€180 per month
- Round-trip airfare- \$2,000
